- Since 2001, more than 150,000 patients in the United States have been notified of potential exposure to hepatitis B virus (HBV), hepatitis C virus (HCV), and HIV due to lapses in basic infection control practices. The North Carolina Division of Public Health (NC DPH) has partnered with the CDC and the *One & Only Campaign* to educate healthcare providers about safe injection practices.
